Covenant Preschool offers one preschool class with 2 teachers for children ages 3 thru 5 years old. The class is divided into smaller learning groups for part of each morning to address the varied learning needs of the children. Children may enroll for two, three, or five days a week, from 9:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. during the regular school year (Sept. - May.)

Our Summer Session meets three days a week (M/W/F) from 9:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. (Dates TBD.)

Lunch and More

11:30 a.m. – 12:30 p.m.
Tuesday and/or Wednesday

Lunch and More is offered on Tues. and Wed. from 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m., immediately following the regular preschool class. Children enrolled in Lunch and More bring a lunch to eat with the group. After eating, teachers provide fun activities that often expand on what children are learning in their regular classroom. (Cost: \$7.00/hr. A minimum of 3 students enrolled per session is required for this class to operate.)

Class Size

At Covenant, we feel it is important to keep student/teacher ratios low to better meet the needs of the group and of individual children. September through May we have 2 teachers and a maximum of 12 children in our preschool classrooms. Our Summer Session (Dates TBD) has 2 teachers and a maximum of 12 children in the class.

Visitation

Parents are welcome to visit the preschool at any time. We have one-way glass in our doors for your convenient observation. You and your child are welcome to visit a class together prior to registering for Covenant Preschool. Please contact the Director to arrange a convenient time.

Communication

Our doors are always open to parents. We have the luxury of speaking with parents daily at drop off and pick up time. We provide a newsletter monthly to inform parents of topics of study and upcoming events, such as VIP Night, Holiday Celebrations, School Photos, Parent/Child Breakfast, Open House, and class visitors. There are also opportunities for parents to volunteer in the classroom if interested.
