Step One

Step Two

On the second Sunday of every month, people may become new members of Covenant Presbyterian Church at any of our three services.

Step Three

Our Nurture and Outreach Commission will support and nurture you in your membership. We will invite you to gatherings for new members, offer a mentor (someone whose been a member here for a while) to personally introduce you to life in this community, and schedule regular classes on what it is to be a Presbyterian and how we can live out our faith.

In our *Book of Order* (the second half of our Presbyterian Constitution), membership is described this way:

G-1.0304 The Ministry of Members

Membership in the Church of Jesus Christ is a joy and privilege. It is also a commitment to participate in Christ's mission. A faithful member bears witness to God's love and grace and promises to be involved responsibly in the ministry of Christ's Church. Such involvement includes

- *proclaiming the good news in word and deed,*
- *taking part in the common life and worship of a congregation,*
- *lifting one another up in prayer, mutual concern, and active support,*
- *studying Scripture and the issues of Christian faith and life,*
- *supporting the ministry of the church through the giving of money, time, and talents,*
- *demonstrating a new quality of life within and through the church,*
- *responding to God's activity in the world through service to others,*
- *living responsibly in the personal, family, vocational, political, cultural, and social relationships of life,*
- *working in the world for peace, justice, freedom, and human fulfillment,*
- *participating in the governing responsibilities of the church, and reviewing and evaluating regularly the integrity of one's membership, and considering ways in which one's participation in the worship and service of the church may be increased and made more meaningful.*
